On the Course with Doyle

Summer has arrived and the grass around the course is loving the higher temperatures. The overseeded areas have almost totally recovered with only a few thin areas left to deal with. It's hard to believe that a year ago we had three and a half holes completely submerged in water. There will still be work left throughout the summer to correct any lingering damage from the water. There are certain areas on fairways four and six that are still quite thin that may require more than just fertilizer to correct. Larger areas that are void or lack enough turf to fill in this summer will be seeded with Bermuda grass. It is extremely important to avoid driving on these areas so that the seedlings have a chance to establish and the grass that survived the flood has a chance to spread and fill in these areas. We would appreciate everyone treating the lake holes as cart path only on a daily basis as this can only expedite the recovery period. It would also help the rest of the course if everyone could refrain from driving on fairways, green slopes, and tee slopes throughout the summer as this can only improve the overall health and playability of the course.

This month we will start spraying fairways, greens and collars and approaches with a growth regulator that will enhance playability as well as reduce the need for frequent mowing. Sometimes this application may result in a temporary discoloration of the turf which is normal and will disappear within about a week. The rest of the month the plan will be to just keep up with maintenance which proves to be quite difficult in July and August. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

News from the Dining Room

Sweet potatoes have long been recognized as an excellent dietary source of vitamins A and B6, beta-carotene and potassium.
