These changes in our typical climate force changes in our agronomic plan. Changes such as herbicide or insecticide application dates tend to be moving to earlier times in the year to maintain adequate pest control. Weed seeds are germinating earlier and of course the dreaded mole crickets are becoming active sooner. Since the majority of our mole cricket battle will not begin until May there may be isolated treatments made to control this pest in areas where the populations are too high or where their damage is resulting in adverse playing conditions. If you decide to walk to play your round of golf and did not pay for a cart, please do not ride in the cart with someone else. If we see you riding in the cart, we will charge your account the cart fee. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Have you been a member for at least a year and want a \$50 credit on your account? We have given about 150 members this credit already! All we need is a credit card number to pay your account balance on the first of each month and an e-mail address for you to receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail only. Then you will receive \$50 credit. Please let us know!

We need your help! Please drive the carts using the 90 Degree Rule. More importantly please keep the carts off the green slopes as much as possible. Golf cart traffic causes more damage than anything else on a golf course. Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, and please fill in all the divots with sand. We thank you for your cooperation.

If you receive your statement and newsletter by e-mail and still receive it by mail and don't want to or need to, please let us know so we can stop sending it in the mail.
