# On the Course with Doyle

The month has arrived in which the golf course will begin its transformation just as many children will do on Halloween as they slip on their favorite costume and enjoy this fun time of the year. As for us, we will be putting the golf courses costume on with the only exception is that it will be for more than just one night. Overseeding a golf course is a brilliant way to keep a golf courses color and playability intact all year round. I find it exhilarating to watch this transformation take place.

The plan for the overseeding has not changed any from years prior but for the benefit of the all the new members I will give a brief summary. Early this month a pre-emergent herbicide will be applied to all Bermuda grass areas that will not be overseeded to reduce the amount of cool season weeds such as Poa Annuua. On the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> we will be overseeding greens with Rough Bluegrass. This date is tentative and could be changed due to inclement weather. The threat of heavy rainfall or windy conditions could result in a delay. Let's keep our fingers crossed that we can stay on schedule. The remaining parts of the course (tees, collars, fairways, and clubhouse surrounds) will be seeded on the days following using a three way blend of ryegrass. I will apologize in advance for any inconvenience the sprinkler system may cause to your round but for optimum germination the seed needs to stay as wet as possible. I appreciate everyone for being a part of and supporting this great facility. Happy Halloween.
