On the Course with Doyle

Overseed! Is it really time to start thinking about that again. Well it is and as always I am looking forward to the transformation. I feel that the summer went well even though we did not receive an adequate amount of rain. The irrigation system did its job and hopefully we will get to start dialing it back a little bit this month. The growth regulator has worked outstanding throughout the summer. The use of this actually helped the grass deal with the dry summer by reducing the need for as much water. The grass was not growing aggressively therefore not as much water was required. I have observed great benefits from this practice and we will continue to treat fairways and greens and eventually include some rough throughout the summer months.

Now back to overseeding. This month, early this month, we be spraying a pre-emergent herbicide on all non overseeded areas to prevent any unwanted weeds from germinating as well as preventing any seed from emerging where it is not supposed to be. There will be a few days where a nine will be closed briefly to accomplish this. This herbicide must either be watered in or dry before any person or golf cart can enter to prevent any tracking from the sprayed area to a planned overseeded area. The dates are not determined yet but will be early this month.

By the end of the month we will have a new set of tees with another color for you to play. I believe everyone will enjoy this new set of tees.

When you are playing golf, if possible pair up with someone on the cart. Our warranty is based on the hours a cart is used, the more carts go out, the quicker the warranty expires. Also, more carts mean more golf cart traffic, which means more damage. We need all the help that we can get in this matter. Thank you.

Always remember to start on #1, groups of more than 4 need to be approved by the pro shop and please let faster groups play through.

We need your help! Please fix the ball marks on the greens, yours and others, please fill in all the divots with sand and rake the bunkers. Please drive the carts using the 90 Degree Rule. More importantly please keep the carts off the tee and green slopes as much as possible. Golf cart traffic causes more damage to the golf course than anything else. We thank you for your cooperation.
