On the Course with Doyle

Some much needed rainfall arrived late last month and definitely relieved the drought stress that occurred early in the month. Many of you probably noticed the off color patches during this drought period especially on the outer edges of the fairways and not down the center. This is because we have what is referred to as single row irrigation. So you see that we are reliant upon an adequate amount of rainfall each summer to avoid these distinct dry areas. These outer edges are also the reason why you may see us irrigating even after a rain. We are trying to simply keep adequate moisture in the soil on the outer edges at the sacrifice of over watering the centers since it may only take a few days for moisture levels to be depleted. You may have also noticed the obvious brown tire tracks through these areas which is a result of cart traffic through a particular area that is under extreme stress. The damage from this is actually worse than driving through wet areas because sometimes it results in turf death. Please keep this information as a reminder that it is always a good practice to avoid driving carts in fairways even if hasn't rained.

It's hard to believe that we are only a little over a month away from overseeding. I really enjoy this process of changing the golf courses appearance. This month we will begin making preparations for overseeding such as raising cutting heights slightly, insecticide applications for mole crickets that survived the initial application, and also most importantly pre-emergent applications to control the dreaded annual bluegrass (*Poa Annua*). There are no surface disrupting plans for the greens the rest of this year with the exception of some light verticutting prior to seeding next month.

Thanks to all of you that braved the heat of the summer and for your continued support of all of the clubs facilities.
