The high heat mixed with some wet conditions along the way made for more than ideal conditions for disease development over the past couple of weeks. Obviously, the greens are our main priority and we have managed to keep it under control with minimal turf loss. Some fairways have developed disease issues which we are trying to correct through a variety of cultural practices since Fungicides tend to be rather expensive. Another problem that was encountered last month is the presence of higher numbers in the mole cricket population. We had multiple hatch periods this year and populations have reached unacceptable levels in areas. Mix that with the insects ability to develop somewhat of a resistance to certain pesticides and we are left with many of these pests wreaking havoc on the course. We have been treating areas where the mole crickets are at unacceptable levels with decent success and we will continue this until we have them back under control. Have a great Labor Day.

We need your help and know everyone has enjoyed being able to ride in a cart by yourself, but we will require everyone to ride with someone. Unfortunately, the golf course does not like it. Golf carts do more damage to the course than anything else. **If you elect to ride by yourself, you will have to pay the single rider surcharge of \$5. If we see you riding by yourself when you could have rode with someone else, we will charge you the single rider fee of \$5 on your account.** We need to reduce the amount of carts on the course, for gas usage and wear on the carts and the course as well. Thank you for your help, understanding and cooperation.
