# On the Course with Doyle

We finally received some much needed rainfall last month and that surely provided some much needed stress relief for the turf. One thing that wasn't harmed by the drought was the dreaded goose grass. That troublesome weed thrives in adverse conditions which is part of what makes it so difficult to control. Post emergent herbicides to control this weed are limited and most have no adverse affect on Bermuda grass do not provide acceptable control therefore are not cost effective. This leaves few options for turf managers and sometimes a more aggressive approach may be the only way to eliminate this weed. Last year I started testing with different chemicals and rates and found moderate success. The hand sprayer applications proved to be the most effective but were not very time efficient therefore we have begun testing on a larger scale. These applications may or may not cause injury to the Bermuda grass which is all dependent on which cultivar it is (Common, 328, 419, Ormond etc.). The testing will continue the rest of the year with hopefully a for sure remedy for Goosegrass will be found.

We will be verticutting/dethatching the greens at the beginning of this month. To keep surface disruption to a minimum we have decided to split this process. On July 2<sup>nd</sup> will be our first direction and July 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> will be our second however if a considerable amount of thatch is removed initially we may opt to skip the second. I know that this is an ugly process but there are enormous benefits from this. Thank you and Happy Independence Day.
